

PUBLISHING REGULATIONS FOR AUTHORS

SINCRONIA, *e-Journal of Philosophy and Literature*, is a biannual electronic publication of the Departments of Philosophy and Letters of the University Center for Social Sciences and Humanities of the University of Guadalajara; It's part of the Register of *Scientific Journals of the University of Guadalajara*, and has benefited in the *Integral Program Access and Knowledge Dissemination (Magazines CONACYT)*.

The central themes of the magazine are on philosophical and literary subjects, not excluding those on history, science, politics, geography, education, etc.; which it aims to spread the knowledge associated with them, approaching them from different disciplinary aspects.

The articles proposed for publication will be forwarded to the Examination Committee for its evaluation and, if approved, will be informed to the authors on this process. In case there are any comments from the evaluators they will be returned to the authors for review and must again be sent to this wording for assessment and final approval.

Content and originality of the collaborations.

SINCRONIA published articles showing the results of research and studies in its various forms, developed in the field of philosophy and literary studies and other disciplines related to the field of social sciences and humanities.

SINCRONIA previously issued a call for the publication of the next issue, indicating therein the deadlines for receiving contributions. The articles submitted to this wording after the deadline indicated in the call will be considered for the next issue of the magazine, subject to the conditions of review and evaluation.

Articles will be written correctly in terms of grammar, syntax and style, without spelling or punctuation errors. Your content should be classified as interesting, clear and informative, unambiguous language and appropriate vocabulary.

The authors, before submitting your article to **SINCRONIA** previously must download the *License of Literary Work* and the *Declaration of Authorship* following these guidelines:

- a) fill them adequately,
- b) print them,
- c) sign them,
- d) scan them and export to PDF and
- e) refer them to the drafting of this magazine.

Proposals must be original, they must not have been published in whole or in part by any means and should be in the publishing process. It must be reported to the magazine if the item has been published or accepted for publication in any other medium other than this. In that case, the magazine will proceed to remove the evaluation process or issue that you are. It is the responsibility of the authors compliance with this standard.

Articles must be original contributions. It is not permitted to copy or translate articles from other authors to publish in **SINCRONIA** under a different authorship or without the permission of the original author. In all other forms of plagiarism and violation of copyright, the magazine recognizes the jurisdiction of federal courts and laws on Copyright.

General criteria for publication.

SINCRONIA e-Journal reserves the right to publish or not the contributions received according to the observance of their governing documents. The decision will be communicated to the author by email.

The ideas expressed in articles are those of the author (s), which delimits the authors **SINCRONIA** full responsibility for their opinions.

Not be publishable any writing that promotes the ideology of political parties, attack on third parties, whether individuals or institutions, glorifies violence or commits or incites discrimination in all its forms.

Cases not provided to pose a potential impediment shall be decided by the Editorial Board.

Sending manuscripts.

Articles should be sent to the following email address: sincronia@csh.udg.mx, or may be hand delivered digitally to the editor of the journal.

It is the responsibility of the authors that the texts sent in strict compliance with the formal requirements for publication of the journal indicated in this policy document.

Selection Process Articles.

All texts will be submitted to a thematic review which will determine whether to continue in the selection process; if so rigorous evaluation of content will be submitted by the Editorial Board and the bodies of arbitration available.

The authors will be informed timeously. Resulting in one of the following situations:

- a) **Rejection.**
- b) **Conditional Acceptance.** For publication, the item will be forwarded to the author with recommendations for modifications to be carried out in the suggested time in the explanatory text to be attached to shipping.
- c) **Acceptance.** The article will be published without substantial changes. The author will receive a notification of overcoming the selection process.

Accepted papers will be scheduled for publication and departure dates will be reported to the authors.

Intellectual property.

The intellectual property of the articles submitted belongs to the authors and the rights of editing and publishing the magazine. Articles published in the journal may be used freely for educational and scientific purposes, provided that proper citation of it is made. Any commercial use is expressly punishable under Mexican law.

Our journal only asks to be informed of a re-publication elsewhere after its publication in **SINCRONIA** and that publication contains the reference of the original publication.

If the text is published in another journal during the selection process, the author shall notify the **SINCRONIA** e-journal in order to remove immediately the process.

Authorization of reproduction.

When you publish your article in **SINCRONIA**, the author accepts the conditions and authorizes the reproduction of the article on the official website of the journal, as well as accepting that readers of it, to copy all or part of the contents thereof, for educational purposes or broadcast, as long as the original source of the journal is cited including the link of the official site of the same.

File characteristics referred.

It is requested that the file be sent in word processor made with .doc or .docx extension. The format of the page letter, margins of 2.5 cm and a maximum length of 30 pages size. The font should be *Arial* or *Curier* size 12pt for body text, and 10pt for footnotes page and line spacing should be 1.5 cm.

By using bleeding paragraphs, must be with the TAB key and align text to the left, including titles and footnotes page.

All submissions must contain:

- a) **Title and / or subtitle.**
- b) **Information of the authors.**
- c) **Abstract** in Spanish and English. Short paragraph of no more than 250 words, a summary of the main points discussed in the article. It does not include citations, figures, charts, and tables.
- d) **Keywords** in Spanish and English. Six words maximum, separated by point, preferably different from those used in the title.

Publishing rules.

The requirements form the article, such as appointments, use of images, literature, etc., they are contained in the document ***Guidelines for Authors***, which can be downloaded directly from the ***Publishing Criteria***.
